#### 2026 MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL BEGINS ON JANUARY 1, 2026 AND ENDS ON FEBRUARY 28, 2026.

Current members in good standing will receive an email on January 2, with details and instructions on how to renew online. Anyone who does not have an email on file, or has previously requested, will receive a paper copy of the renewal form in the mail. Please do not renew online before January 2, 2026. Doing so will delay activation of your 2026 membership.

IMPORTANT-Recently approved by-laws and procedures require that ALL MEMBERS who are requesting a change to their member profile, (name, membership level, address, phone or email) must email membership@gacemail.org with the changes. Members may no longer make these changes themselves. Please let us know ASAP if you plan to add or drop a spouse or if your contact information has changed this year and you have not yet notified us.

A primary member, (the person whose name appears first or only on your membership profile) is the person in whose name the membership is listed. Spouses are granted membership regardless of heritage but cannot take over the membership to become the primary member.

Scrip expires on 2/28/26. Please do not wait until the last minute to discover your card is not working. After February 15th, we cannot guarantee card replacement in time to use Scrip before the deadline.

## STAIR NA HÉIREANN | IRISH HISTORY LECTURE FEBRUARY 1ST 2026 @ 2PM WITH ELIZABETH STACK, PHD, CONTESTED CITIZENS: IRISH AND GERMAN IMMIGRANTS

Elizabeth Stack, PhD, Director of Education at Celtic Junction Arts Center in St. Paul, MN. Dr. Stack is the recent recipient of the 2025 Heroes of Irish America Award. She was the Executive Director of the American Irish Historical Society in New York City and prior to that was executive director of the Irish American Heritage Museum in Albany, NY.

Elizabeth Stack will explore the subject of how the two largest immigrant groups chose to define their ethnic identity amidst myriad Americanization policies, making it possible for other groups to be ethnic Americans.
